JLT Mobile Computers Ranked Number 149 Fastest Growing Technology Company In North America On The 2006 Deloitte Technology Fast 500

JLT Mobile Computers Experiences 1,281% Percent Revenue Growth; Only Arizona Company to Be Named on List

TEMPE, AZ.—October 19, 2006—JLT Mobile Computers, a leading provider of rugged, wireless mobile computers built for use in challenging environments, today announced that it ranked Number 149 on the 2005 Deloitte Technology Fast 500, a ranking of the 500 fastest growing technology, media, telecommunications and life sciences companies in North America. Rankings are based on percentage revenue growth over five years, from 2001-2005. JLT Mobile Computers grew 1,281% percent during this period and is the only Arizona-based company on the list.

Fast 500 Selection and Qualifying Criteria

The Fast 500 ranks the fastest growing technology, media, telecommunications and life sciences companies in North America. It is compiled from Deloitte’s 16 regional North American Fast 50 programs, nominations submitted directly to the Fast 500, and public company database research. Companies are selected based on percentage revenue growth from 2001 to 2005.

Entrants must own proprietary intellectual property or proprietary technology that contributes to a significant portion of the company’s operating revenues or devote a signifi-

cant proportion of revenues to research and development of technology. Using other companies' technology or intellectual property in a unique way does not qualify. Base-year operating revenues must be at least \$50,000 USD or \$75,000 CD, and current-year operating revenues must be at least \$5 million USD or CD. Companies must be in business a minimum of five years, and they must be headquartered within North America.
